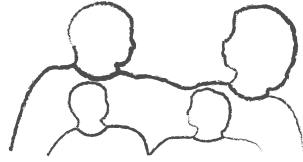

Mission Statement

The New Jersey Black Issues Convention, Inc. (NJBIC) is a Black Leadership statewide roundtable of organizations in the State of New Jersey, established as a united, representative organization uniquely qualified to speak to the concerns of the Black residents of the state. Member organizations represent various Black groups: religious, civil rights, labor, business, professional, social, fraternal, educational, foreign affairs, urban and rural policy, youth, and senior citizens.

The purpose of the New Jersey Black Issues Convention is:

- To discuss critical issues affecting the Black community
- To provide a regular exchange of information among the leaders of Black organizations state-wide
- To implement the “Black Leadership Family Plan” through Black organizations in New Jersey
- To make possible opportunities and resources to meet the changing needs of the Black community
- To work in unison with local, state and national agencies that are performing functions to assist in the areas of health, education, economic development, social and job placement (career orientation) needs.

The New Jersey Black Issues Convention is incorporated as a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of New Jersey and is a tax-exempt institution under Internal Revenue Service regulation 501(c)(3). Membership is open to all predominantly Black state-wide organizations or those that maintain a state-wide perspective and state-wide program of action.
